

Requirements for jumper distance in distribution boxes

Article Overview

Jumpers in LT distribution boxes must maintain adequate spacing from bus bars and the box body, with proper insulation and flexibility to ensure safety and reliable current flow.

Jumper Spacing and Clearance

Inside low-voltage distribution boxes, jumpers (bus connections) should be positioned to provide sufficient clearance from the box body and other conductors to prevent short circuits and ensure compliance with electrical safety standards. The spacing is influenced by:

- Phase-to-phase distance: Jumpers connecting different phases should maintain a minimum clearance according to I.E. rules applicable for LT supply to avoid arcing or insulation breakdown .
- Bus bar arrangement: Typically, a single bus bar arrangement is used with 4-pole MCCB for all capacities, and jumpers must be sized and routed to avoid contact with the box walls .
- Insulation: Heat-shrinkable bus bar insulation tubing or phase-colored insulated paint (Red, Yellow, Blue, Black) is recommended to cover jumpers and maintain safe distances .
