

Single-mode single-fiber switch

A single mode fiber switch is an optical device that selectively routes light signals in single mode fibers, enabling flexible network configurations with low insertion loss and high reliability.

Overview

Single mode fiber switches are passive or MEMS-based devices that control the direction of light in single mode optical fibers, allowing signals to be transmitted, blocked, or redirected without converting them to electrical signals. Unlike multimode switches, single mode switches allow only the fundamental transverse mode to propagate, eliminating speckle effects and improving measurement accuracy in optical instrumentation.

Types and Configurations

Single mode fiber switches come in various configurations:

- 1x1 switches: Simple on/off switching between a single input and output.
- 1xN or 2xN switches: Redirect one or two inputs to multiple outputs, commonly used in testing or network reconfiguration.
- NxM matrix switches: Complex routing between multiple inputs and outputs, supporting configurations like 2x4, 8x8, or even 26x16. The switches can be mechanically driven using stepping motors and fiber collimators or MEMS-based, where micro-mirrors redirect light with high precision.
