

Spacing of galvanized fireproof cable trays in West Africa

Article Overview

For galvanized fireproof cable trays, horizontal spacing between parallel trays should be at least 0.6 meters, vertical spacing at least 150 mm, and cables should be secured every 3-5 meters horizontally and every 1.5 meters vertically.

Horizontal and Vertical Tray Spacing

- Parallel trays: Maintain a minimum horizontal distance of 0.6 meters to allow maintenance access, proper airflow, and reduce the risk of cable contact or short circuits .
- Power and signal separation: Keep at least 0.5 meters between power and signal trays to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI). If trays are shielded, this distance can be reduced to 0.3 meters .
- Vertical spacing: For floor-mounted or stacked trays, maintain a minimum vertical clearance of 150 mm to prevent obstruction and allow future cable additions .

Cable Securing and Support

- Horizontal runs: Secure cables at the start, end, turns, and every 3-5 meters along straight sections .
- Vertical runs: Secure cables at the top and every 1.5 meters .
- Binding: Cable ties should not exceed 1.5 meters apart to ensure even tension and organization .
- Hanging rods: Use rods of at least 8 mm diameter for vertical support to maintain...
