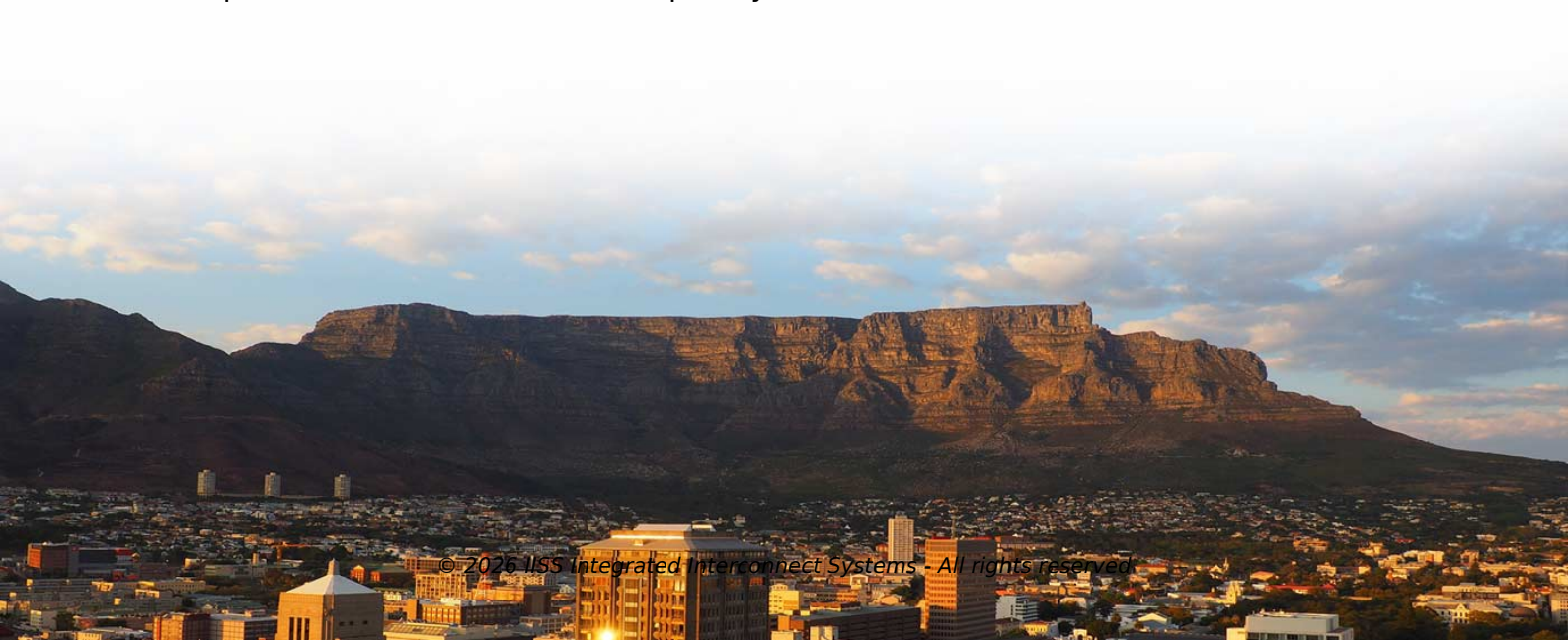


Standard Requirements for Communication Fiber Optic Cable Cabling
