

Standard Size of Emergency Lighting Distribution Box

Article Overview

Emergency lighting distribution boxes typically range from compact 300×300×150 mm units to larger 600×600×200 mm enclosures, depending on circuit capacity and fire-resistance requirements.

Typical Dimensions

Emergency lighting distribution boxes are designed to house components such as automatic transfer switches (ATS), miniature circuit breakers (MCBs), residual current devices (RCDs), and fire alarm forced-closure modules . The physical size of the box depends on the number of circuits it supports and whether it includes additional modules for fire safety or monitoring. Common dimensions include:

- Small units: approximately 300–400 mm height × 300–400 mm width × 150–200 mm depth, suitable for 4–8 circuits.
- Medium units: approximately 500–600 mm height × 500–600 mm width × 200 mm depth, supporting 8–16 circuits.
- Large units: 600–800 mm height × 600–800 mm width × 250–300 mm depth, for 16–32 circuits or more, often used in commercial or industrial buildings.

Enclosure and Mounting Considerations

- Material: Steel or fire-resistant composite, sometimes rated for 850°C/120 minutes for fire protection
