

Standard configuration of secondary power distribution box in shopping mall

A typical secondary power distribution box in a shopping mall includes a main incoming switch, busbars, protective devices (MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs), neutral and earth bars, and multiple outgoing circuits for zoned load distribution.

Key Components

Incoming Supply and Main Switch: The box receives power from the main distribution panel or floor-level hub. A main switch or isolator allows complete disconnection for maintenance or emergency purposes . **Busbars:** Three-phase copper busbars are commonly used to handle high commercial currents efficiently, provide superior heat dissipation, and prevent arcing or terminal loosening . They distribute power to multiple outgoing circuits. **Protective Devices:**

- **MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers):** Protect individual branch circuits from overload and short circuits.
 - **RCDs/RCBOs:** Provide earth leakage protection to prevent electric shock and fire hazards.
 - **Surge Protective Devices (SPD):** Protect sensitive equipment from voltage spikes .
- Neutral and Earth Bars:** Organize neutral and protective earth conductors, ensuring safe and reliable grounding . **Outgoing Circuits:** Secondary distribution boxes typically have multiple outgoing circuits (e.g., 4, 6, 8, or 12 ways) to serve different zones such as retail stores, corridors, food courts, and public areas. Each branch is independently protected, so a fault in one circuit does not affect others
