

Standard for Protective Covers of Secondary Distribution Boxes

Article Overview

Protective covers for secondary distribution boxes must comply with NEC, IEEE, OSHA, and NEMA standards to ensure safety, durability, and proper electrical performance.

Key Standards and Requirements

1. National Electrical Code (NEC) Compliance NEC Article 314 specifies requirements for electrical boxes and enclosures, including secondary distribution boxes. Covers must:

- Be securely fastened and flush with the finished surface to prevent fire spread and allow safe access to wiring compartments (314.20, 314.21)
- Protect conductors from physical damage and prevent openings that could compromise insulation or allow foreign objects (314.5, 314.23)
- Be compatible with the box type (metallic or nonmetallic) and properly grounded if metal (314.4)
- Ensure box fill calculations are met to avoid overcrowding, which could lead to overheating or electrical hazards . 2. IEEE Standards IEEE C62.34-2017 addresses low-voltage surge protective devices used on secondary distribution systems. While primarily focused on surge protection, it implies that enclosures housing these devices must:
 - Be rated for low-voltage applications (≤ 1000 V rms)
 - Provide safe access for installation and maintenance of secondary arresters...
