

Standard safety color for level 3 distribution boxes

The standard safety color for level 3 distribution boxes is typically safety orange, indicating a potentially hazardous situation requiring caution.

Explanation

Level 3 distribution boxes are generally associated with high-voltage electrical equipment that presents a serious risk of injury but not an immediate life-threatening hazard. According to ANSI Z535.1-2022, safety colors are assigned based on the severity and immediacy of the hazard. Orange is used to signal a potentially hazardous situation that could result in serious injury or death if not avoided, making it the standard choice for electrical panels and distribution boxes that require attention but do not pose an immediate emergency like fire or live contact with exposed high voltage .

Color Specifications

- Safety Orange is commonly represented by hex codes #FF7900, #FF6700, or #FF6600 .
- The color should be predominantly orange with contrasting lettering or symbols to ensure visibility and quick hazard recognition .
- This color coding aligns with OSHA and ANSI guidelines for warning-level hazards, distinguishing it from red (danger) or yellow (caution) which are used for immediate life-threatening hazards or minor risks, respectively
