

The distribution box has no sheathed wires

Overview

The fix for “Unsheathed Basic Insulation” is to simply re-terminate the cable and properly take the sheathing into the enclosure. This can cause problems on cables if there is not enough spare to enable it to be cut back and sorted. A conduit body is a removable-cover section of a conduit system that provides access at junctions or termination points. However, the key to. Metal raceways, cable trays, cable armor, cable sheath, enclosures, frames, fittings, and other metal noncurrent-carrying parts that are to serve as grounding conductors, with or without the use of supplementary equipment grounding conductors, shall be effectively bonded where necessary to ensure.
