

The fusion of the fiber optic cable and pigtail cable affects internet speed

Proper fusion splicing of fiber optic cables to pigtails minimally affects internet speed, but poor splicing or connector issues can introduce signal loss that reduces network performance.

How Fusion Splicing Works

A fiber optic pigtail is a short fiber with a factory-polished connector on one end and bare fiber on the other. The bare end is fusion-spliced to the main fiber optic cable inside a distribution box or closure, creating a permanent, low-loss connection . Fusion splicing aligns the fiber cores precisely and melts them together, resulting in insertion loss typically around 0.1 dB, which is much lower than mechanical splices or field-polished connectors . This low loss ensures that high-speed internet signals, including gigabit and multi-gigabit connections, are transmitted efficiently.

While fusion splicing itself is highly efficient, several factors can influence performance:

- **Splice Quality:** Misalignment, core diameter mismatch, or contamination can increase insertion loss and back reflection, which may degrade signal strength and reduce effective bandwidth .
- **Connector Type and Polish:** Using the wrong connector type (e.g., LC vs SC) or pol...
