In wastewater treatment or transformer oil monitoring, the fiber is exposed to the medium, and changes in light transmission or attenuation indicate the presence and concentration of sludge. For example, multimode fibers like OM4 can measure absorption changes caused by sludge particles, providing real-time feedback on sludge formation and preventing excessive accumulation that could disrupt operations or damage equipment....
