Two-core fusion splice pigtails serve as a precise, low-loss bridge between factory-terminated connectors and field-installed fiber cables, enabling reliable dual-fiber connections in optical networks.

Function and Design

A two-core pigtail is a short fiber optic cable with two factory-terminated connectors on one end and bare fiber cores on the other, designed for fusion splicing to incoming fiber cables in the field . Unlike patch cords, which have connectors on both ends, pigtails allow technicians to create permanent, low-loss connections between the network backbone and active equipment, such as ODF ports, patch panels, or terminal boxes . The dual-core design supports simultaneous transmission of two fibers, commonly used for duplex communication or redundant links.

Fusion Splicing Process

The bare ends of the two-core pigtail are stripped, cleaned, and aligned with the corresponding fibers of the trunk or distribution cable using a fusion splicer . The splicer applies a localized electric arc to weld the glass fibers together, producing a nearly seamless joint with minimal insertion loss (typically 0.01–0.05 dB) and high return loss . This ensures signal integrity and long-term reliability, which is critical for high-speed data, FTTH, or carrier networks.
