Common types include SFP, SFP+, QSFP, and CFP modules, supporting different speeds and distances . 2. Optical Switch Modules: These include mechanical or MEMS-based switches that can route optical signals between multiple ports. Examples include 2x2 bidirectional cross switches or 1xN MEMS switches, which allow flexible routing and protection in optical networks . MEMS switches offer fast switching (
