Fibre Channel networks are categorized by topologies and port types, including point-to-point, arbitrated loop, switched fabric, and ports like N_Port, F_Port, E_Port, L_Port, NL_Port, FL_Port, and G_Port.

Fibre Channel Topologies

- Point-to-Point (P2P): This is the simplest topology, connecting two devices directly with a dedicated link. It provides full bandwidth to both devices and is suitable for high-speed, low-latency connections between a host and a storage device .
- Arbitrated Loop (FC-AL): Devices are connected in a one-way ring. Ports use arbitration to determine which device can transmit data at a given time. This topology can support up to 126 devices on a single loop and is still used internally in some switches .
- Switched Fabric (FC-SW): The most common modern topology, where multiple switches form a fabric. Each node can communicate with multiple other nodes simultaneously, providing high scalability and performance. This topology supports concurrent connections and is widely used in enterprise SANs .

Fibre Channel Port Types

- N_Port (Node Port): Typically a host bus adapter (HBA) port on a node that connects to a switch's F_Port or another N_Port .
- F_Port (Fabric Port): A switch port that connects to an N_Port, enabling communication within the fabric .
- E_Port (Expansion Port): Used to connect two switches together, forming an inter-switch link to expand the fabric .
- L_Port (Loop Port): A port on a node that participates in an arbitrated loop
