

Vertical cable tray installation distance

Article Overview

For vertical cable tray runs, maintain a minimum vertical clearance of 150 mm between trays and secure cables at the top and every 1.5 meters along the tray.

Vertical Spacing and Clearance

When installing floor-mounted or vertical cable trays, the minimum vertical distance between trays should be 150 millimeters (6 inches) to allow for proper ventilation, maintenance access, and future expansion . For trays installed in suspended ceilings or concealed spaces, a vertical clearance of 80 millimeters from the cover access side is recommended to facilitate cable handling and inspection . Additionally, the top of the tray should maintain at least 300 millimeters (0.3 meters) from the ceiling or other obstructions to ensure safe installation and airflow .

Cable Securing and Support

For vertical runs, cables should be fastened at the top of the tray and at intervals not exceeding 1.5 meters to prevent sagging and maintain orderly alignment . This also helps reduce mechanical stress on the conductors and ensures compliance with NEC 392.30(A) requirements . At transition points, such as where cables enter equipment or another raceway, additional support and strain relief are necessary to protect terminations .
