

Vertical installation of trough-type cable trays

Article Overview

Installing vertical trough-type cable trays requires proper support, secure fastening, and adherence to NEC standards to ensure safe and reliable cable routing.

Step 1: Planning and Tray Selection

Begin by reviewing the project's Bill of Quantities (BOQ) to confirm tray sizes, weight capacity, and materials. Choose a ventilated trough tray for vertical runs, which provides continuous support for smaller control or instrumentation cables while allowing moderate ventilation. Consider environmental factors such as moisture or corrosive conditions; in such cases, fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) trays may be preferred.

Step 2: Determine Support Locations

Vertical trays must be securely supported to prevent sagging or stress on cables. Supports are typically placed every 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray strength and load. For vertical installations, ensure supports are anchored to structural elements such as walls or steel frames. Use brackets or clamps rated for the tray type and load.

Step 3: Mounting the Tray

- Attach support brackets at the predetermined intervals.
- Position the vertical trough tray against the supports. Ensure it is plumb and align...
