

What does DFP mean in an optical module

Overview

The DFB laser is based on the FP laser and uses a grating filter device to make the device have only one longitudinal mode output. DFB (Distributed Feedback Laser) generally also uses two wavelengths of 1310nm and 1550nm, which are divided into cooling and no cooling. Three full-field optical techniques, shadow moiré, digital image correlation (DIC), and fringe projection (performed by the DFP-M) are used at Akrometrix for measuring flatness. For example, the transmission distance is generally within 20 km. The optical module serves as a crucial component in optical fiber communication systems, operating at the physical layer, which is the lowest layer in the OSI model. Along with the DSFP interface, there are two other 100G interface standards: SFP-DD and SFP112.
