Optical Cable Types for Power Lines

1. Optical Ground Wire (OPGW) OPGW cables combine optical fibers with a metallic ground wire, typically installed at the top of transmission towers. The fibers are housed in a sealed metal tube at the cable's core, surrounded by steel strength members and aluminum conductors. This design allows the cable to function as both a grounding conductor and a high-speed communication link. OPGW is widely used for long-distance transmission and generally employs singlemode fibers for high-bandwidth communication . 2. Optical Power Phase Conductor (OPPC) OPPC cables integrate optical fibers directly into the phase conductors of power lines. Like OPGW, the fibers are protected from electrical interference and environmental stress. OPPC allows utilities to transmit data along the same path as the electrical power, reducing the need for separate communication infrastructure . 3. Optical Power Attached Cable (OPAC) OPAC is a lightweight, all-dielectric fiber optic cable that is wrapped around existing power or ground conductors. Installation is often done using a "Sky-Wrap" method, where the cable is helically wrapped around the host conductor. OPAC is suitable for expanding communication capacity on existing lines without major structural modifications. Due to its small size, OPAC typically carries fewer fibers than OPGW or OPPC but can be installed in multiple layers if needed
