

What type of cable is used in a secondary distribution box

Secondary distribution boxes typically use duplex or triplex aluminum cables rated for 600 volts or less, with cross-linked polyethylene insulation suitable for direct burial or duct installation.

Common Cable Types

- Duplex Cable
 - Configuration: One insulated phase conductor and one neutral conductor.
 - Use: Single-phase, two-wire systems (120V or 120/240V).
 - Material: Aluminum conductors (AAC or AAAC) with XLPE insulation.
 - Installation: Can be buried directly or installed in ducts .
- Triplex Cable
 - Configuration: Two insulated phase conductors and one neutral conductor (bare or insulated).
 - Use: Single-phase, three-wire systems, commonly for residential or small commercial connections.
 - Material: Stranded aluminum conductors with cross-linked polyethylene insulation.
 - Installation: Suitable for underground service, ducts, or overhead service drops .
- Quadruplex Cable
 - Configuration: Three insulated phase conductors and one neutral conductor.
 - Use: Three-phase, four-wire systems for industrial facilities or apartment complexes.
 - Material: Aluminum conductors with XLPE insulation.
 - Installation: Can be used for short-distance power distribution or overhead service drops .

Key Features

- Voltage Rating: Typically 600 volts or less for secondary distribution.
- Conductor Material: Aluminum is preferred for its lightweight, corrosion resistance, and good conductivity.
- Insulation: Cross-linked polyethylene (XLPE) or polyethylene (PE) for heat, UV, and moisture resistance.
- Neutral Identification: Often marked with yellow stripes or solid yellow; some designs allow black neutrals if specified....
