

What types of ADSS fiber optic cables are there

ADSS fiber optic cables are all-dielectric, self-supporting aerial cables available primarily in central tube and stranded (multi-loose tube) designs.

Overview of ADSS Cable

ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) cables are designed to span between poles or towers without metallic components, making them safe for installation near high-voltage power lines (110 kV to 500 kV) and eliminating induced current risks. They incorporate high-strength non-metallic materials, typically aramid yarn (Kevlar®), to provide tensile strength and support their own weight across long spans, often up to 1,500 meters. The optical fibers inside are housed in loose buffer tubes or ribbon configurations, with water-blocking compounds and protective jackets to maintain long-term fiber integrity.

Primary Structural Types

1. Central Tube Design

- Structure: Optical fibers are placed in a single PBT loose tube filled with water-blocking gel. Aramid yarn is helically wrapped around the tube, and the assembly is extruded with a PE (polyethylene) or anti-tracking (AT) outer jacket.
- Applications: Ideal for short to medium spans (50-150 meters) and low to medium fiber counts (12-48 cores)....
