Key Placement Considerations

Central Location: Position the ONT in a central area of your home to ensure even Wi-Fi coverage to all rooms, especially if the router will be connected nearby . **Proximity to Power:** The ONT requires a reliable power source, so placing it near an electrical breaker panel or outlet is essential . Consider adding a UPS or surge protector to maintain connectivity during power fluctuations . **Accessibility:** Choose a location that is easy to access for maintenance or troubleshooting. Avoid tight corners or areas behind heavy furniture . **Cable Routing:** Plan the path from the fiber entry point to the ONT carefully. Avoid sharp bends, high-traffic areas, or places where the cable could be damaged . Indoor fiber cables should be fire-resistant and flexible, while outdoor cables should be protected from moisture and physical stress . **Environmental Protection:** Keep the ONT away from direct sunlight, moisture, and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing it in basements prone to flooding or near heat sources . **Connection to Router:** The ONT should be close enough to the router to allow a short Cat6 Ethernet connection, which reduces signal loss and ensures high-speed performance . **High-Bandwidth Areas:** If certain rooms, like a home office or entertainment center, require higher speeds, consider placing the ONT or additional network outlets nearby to minimize cable length and maximize performance
