Fire cable trays typically contain power, control, instrumentation, and communication cables that are rated for flame retardancy and fire resistance.

Common Types of Cables in Fire Cable Trays

- Type TC (Tray Cable) – These are factory-assembled cables with two or more insulated conductors, optionally including grounding conductors, under a non-metallic jacket. They are rated for 600 volts and are suitable for industrial power or control circuits where flame retardant properties are required. TC cables can be installed in cable trays, raceways, and outdoor locations if supported properly, and are UL listed for hazardous locations and Class 1 control circuits .
- Type ITC (Instrumentation Tray Cable) – These cables are used for instrumentation and control applications. They may be shielded or unshielded and consist of multiple single conductors or twisted pairs, sometimes with metal armor. ITC cables are designed to maintain signal integrity and resist fire propagation .
- Low Voltage Control and Data Cables – Fire-rated low voltage cables, including communication, data, and signal cables, are often installed in fire cable trays. These cables are designed to maintain circuit integrity during a fire and minimize smoke and toxic gas emissions .

- Firestopping: When cable trays pass through walls, floors, or slabs, openings must be sealed with fire-resistant materials such as firestop packs, mineral wool, or firestop...
