

Wiring Principle of Relay Protection Devices

Relay protection wiring ensures that protective relays reliably detect faults and operate circuit breakers to isolate faulty sections while maintaining system stability.

Overview of Relay Wiring

Relay protection devices are connected to the power system through current transformers (CTs) and voltage transformers (VTs), which step down high currents and voltages to levels suitable for relay operation. The wiring behind these devices includes:

- Control circuits: These connect the relay to the circuit breaker trip and close coils, alarm indicators, and auxiliary contacts.
- Signal circuits: CT and VT secondary outputs are wired to the relay inputs, ensuring accurate measurement of current and voltage.
- Auxiliary circuits: Provide DC supply, indication, and interlocking functions.

Terminal Numbering and Connections

Standard terminal numbering is used to simplify wiring and maintenance:

- Coil terminals: Typically 85 and 86 for the relay coil.
- Contact terminals: 30, 87, and 87a for normally open (NO) and normally closed (NC) contacts
